BRAZIL'S OFFICIAL TRACEABILITY



Official traceability is guaranteed by a three-tier structure, responsible for maintaining agricultural health throughout Brazil.

ROLES OF EACH ANIMAL HEALTH INSTITUTION

MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE - FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

- Formulates Federal Standards and Guidelines;
- Audits and enhances the Quality of Veterinary Services (PVS/OIE);
- Consolidates Information provided by State-level Agricultural Health Agencies;
- International Agricultural Surveillance (Ports, Airports and Borders);
- MAPA's Agricultural Management Platform - PGA;
- Bovine and Buffalo Certification and Identification System SISBOV;
- Federal Inspect of Products of Animal Origin (SIF);

27 STATE-LEVEL AGRICULTURE HEALTH AGENCIES

- Consolidate of information from municipality-level offices;
- Carrys out epidemiological analyses;
- Control interstate animal transit;
- Suspends animal transit when diseases are notified;

4,700 MUNICIPAL-LEVEL OFFICES

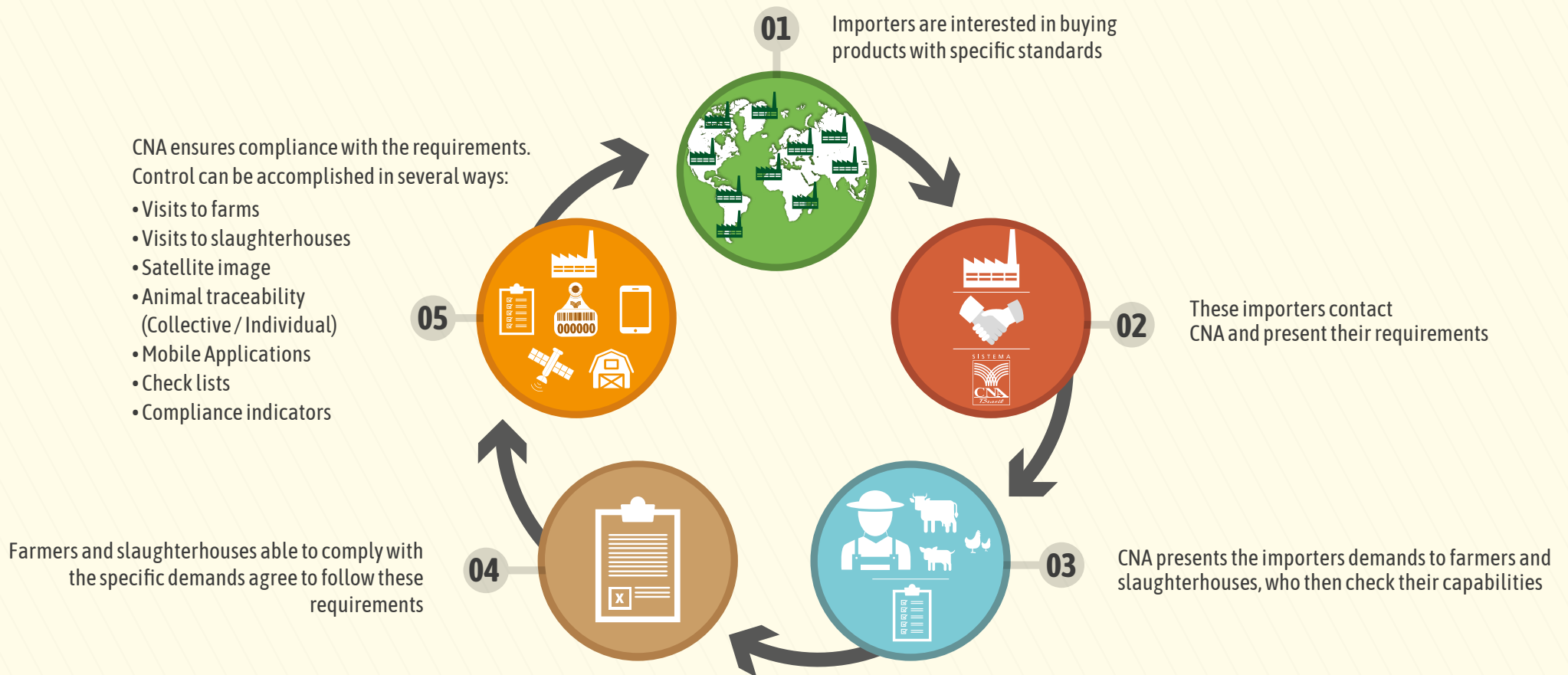
- Carry out registration of farm properties;
- Control herd size;
- Receives farms vaccination information;
- Notified state and federal agencies of disease occurrences;
- Issue of Animal Transit Documents (GTA);

AGRI TRACE CNA BRAZIL: TRANSPARENCY AND GUARANTEES

Over the last years, Brazil has invested in technology and intensified the control over its meat production. This investment aims to serve our consumer markets. To organize the beef supply chain and provide greater transparency, the Brazilian Confederation of Agriculture and Livestock (CNA) and the Brazilian Beef Exporters Association (ABIEC) have developed a system that enables the management of voluntary traceability protocols.

This is Agri Trace CNA-Brazil, which uses both official Brazilian agricultural defense data and new information, provided by the private sector itself. The idea is to ensure compliance with each buyer's specific requirements, based on the agreements made between Brazilian producers and the importers.
